Voting Methods:

1. Applying for a Mail-In Ballot Online:

NOTE: Application Deadline: Tuesday, September 14, 2021 by 3 pm Pacific Time

This method requires an online application including downloading personal ID information. Registration requires computer knowledge and access to scanner/fax. Once the application is submitted and received, a mail-in ballot with prepaid envelope will be mailed out to be completed by the voter and mailed in according to the instructions. 2. Applying for a Mail-In Ballot in Person

NOTE: Application Deadline: Tuesday, September 14, 2021 by 6 pm Pacific Time

You can pick up an application for a mail in package at the Elections Canada office, take home, complete the application form and drop off the application at the Elections Canada office with ID. You cannot apply for a spouse unless that person is unable to able to access the Elections Canada office due to medical/physical limitations in which case you will need your spouse's ID.

3. Vote in Person with a Special Ballot

NOTE: Deadline to Vote is Tuesday, September 14, 2021 by 6 pm Pacific Time

You can vote in person with a special ballot at any Elections Canada office when they are open. Bring your ID and you must know the correct spelling of the name of the candidate you wish to vote for (no lists provided).

4. Vote on Advanced Polling (Voting) Dates

NOTE: You must Vote in Person at your Assigned Polling Station

Bring your ID! Advanced Voting Dates are:

Friday, September 11 Saturday, September 12 Sunday, September 13 Monday, September 14

Polls open from 9 am to 9 pm on each Advanced Voting Dates
